Pour se rappeler la Palestine, les récits reviennent souvent à l'avant-catastrophe. La nakba devient l'événement fondateur d'une nation dispersée. Le recours à l'histoire orale est par conséquent essentiel pour la reconstitution de la mémoire palestinienne. Dans cette optique, l'actuel ouvrage s'attache à en cerner les traces dans les camps de réfugiés de Jordanie et du Liban, parmi les Palestiniens émigrés dans

d'autres pays arabes, enfin en Cisjordanie et à Gaza même où les habitants restés sur place depuis 1948 ont vu le retour des réfugiés (les returnees) après les accords d'Oslo de 1993 et la mise en place de l'autorité palestinienne. Cette exploration des multiples territoires de la mémoire palestinienne, des formes qu'elle revêt et des usages qu'elle sert, s'est nourrie de la richesse des matériaux collectés par un ensemble de jeunes chercheurs qui ont revisité le difficile terrain palestinien, armés des problématiques les plus novatrices en sciences humaines. Les études qu'ils proposent sont autant d'éléments inédits pour une histoire sociale de la mémoire palestinienne.
